UPV Campus is like a city within the city of Valencia



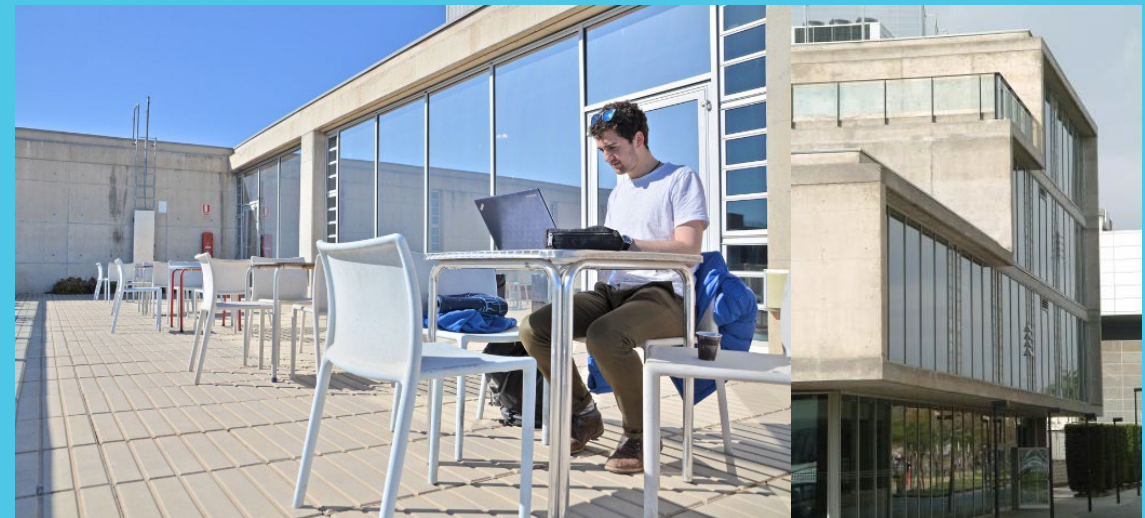
Student's Building - Casa del Alumno



UPV StudyAbroad Program Courses

Technology & Engineering

Engineering thermodynamics, Dynamics, Statics, Digital Logic Design and Software development are some of the courses in the program related to engineering and Technology.

Topics to be covered, depending on the course, include thermodynamics, electrostatics and electrodynamics, magnetism, and electromagnetic oscillations. Also forecasting, customer service and inventory management, just-in-time production, supply chain management, and quality assessment and improvement in both services and manufacturing.

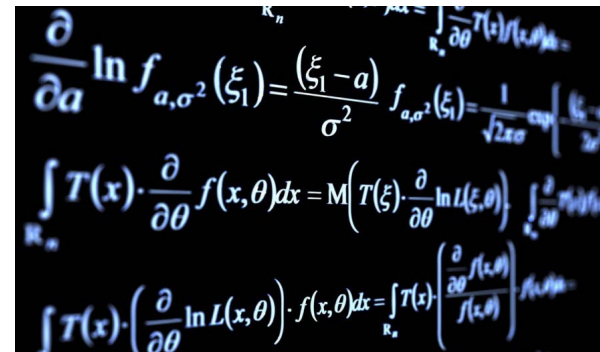
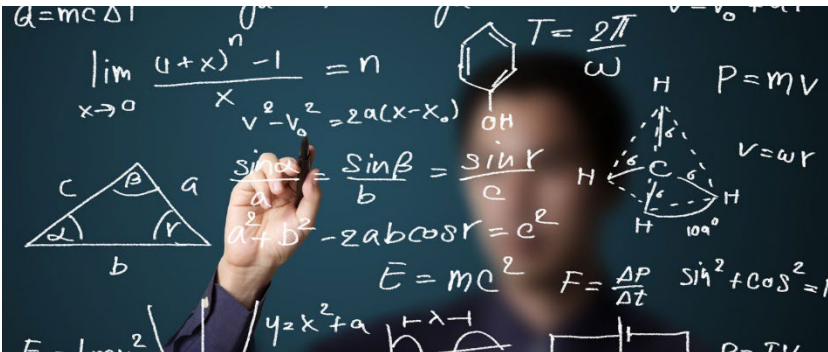


UPV StudyAbroad Program Courses

Mathematics

The offered courses are Differential equations, Precalculus Algebra, Calculus and Analytic trigonometry among others.

Topic covered in these courses are functions and graphs, especially high degree polynomial, rational, exponential, and logarithmic functions; systems of equations; solutions of linear systems; matrix methods; determinants; sequences and series; induction; and the binomial theorem. The course also explores applications, approximation, and methods of proof.



UPV StudyAbroad Program Courses

Science

Courses for developing scientist skills like general and organic chemistry, biology and Physics with laboratory sessions with expert teachers in their area.

The UPV has updated laboratories so the students can learn about topics such as stoichiometry, atomic spectra, gases, as well as acids and bases.



UPV StudyAbroad Program Courses

Business and Economics courses

Courses for acquiring knowledge in strategic management and business organization, like Operation Management, International Business, Professional Communication and Principles of Marketing, with expert teachers in their area.

Students will develop the ability to effectively analyze communication, negotiation, and decision-making in a multicultural business world. Additionally, students will gain a solid theoretical foundation for effectively forecasting and analyzing the services demanded by customers, supply chain management processes, and how to improve quality in services as well as manufacturing.

Spanish language & culture

Some of the courses are Spanish language, from elementary to advanced, Spanish culture and civilization and Survey of Spanish Literature.

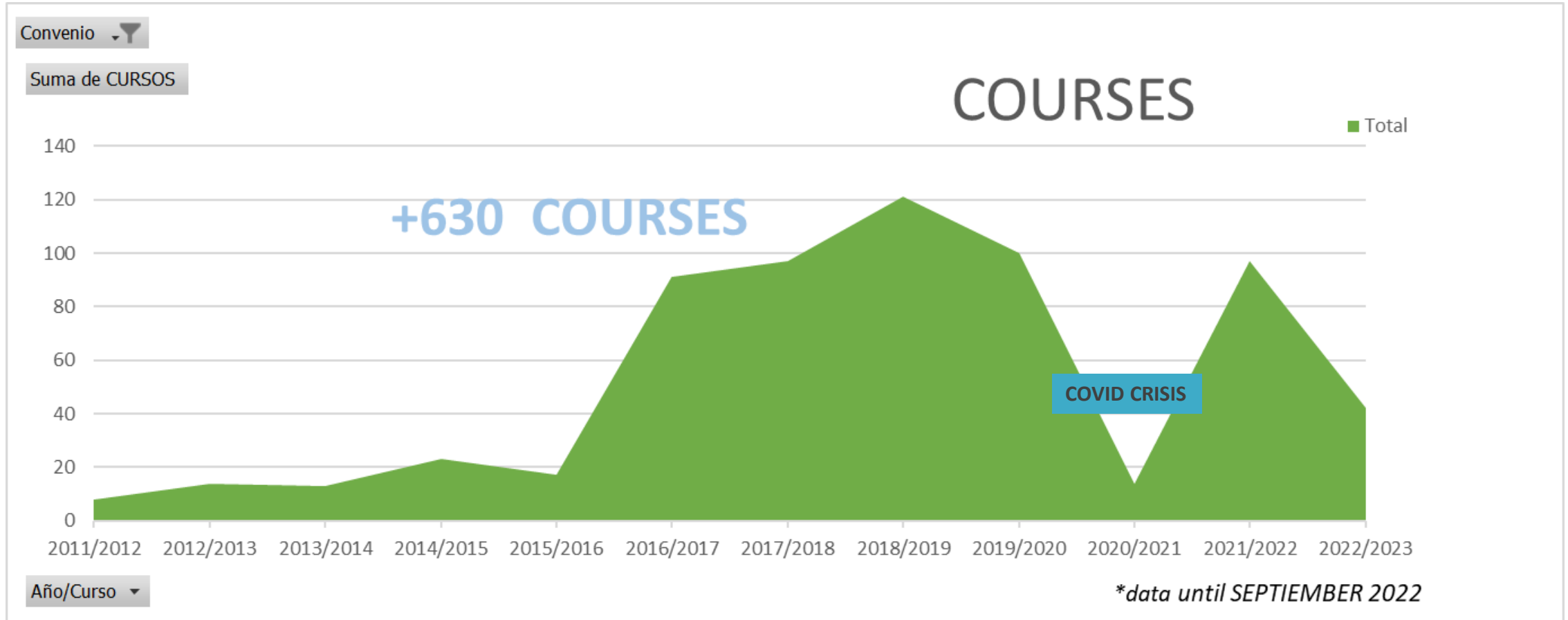

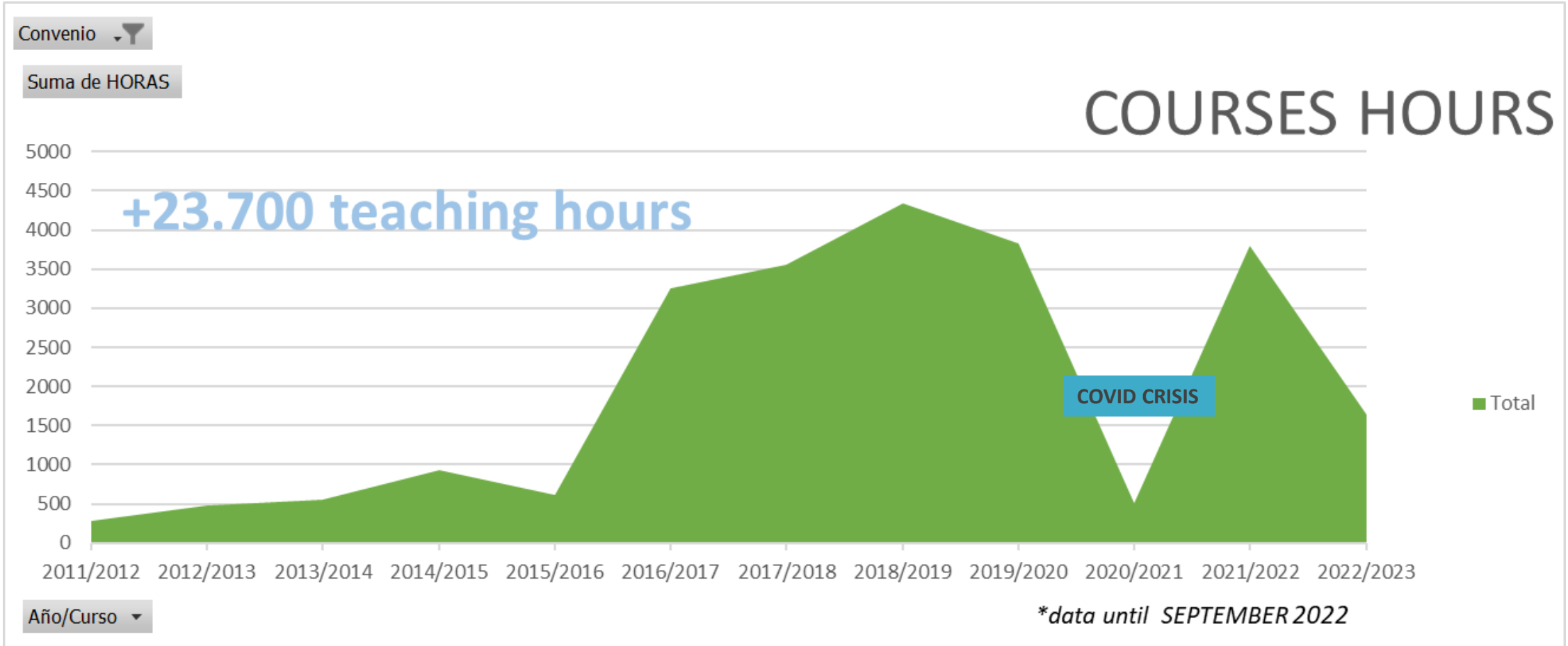
Evolution of taught courses Graph





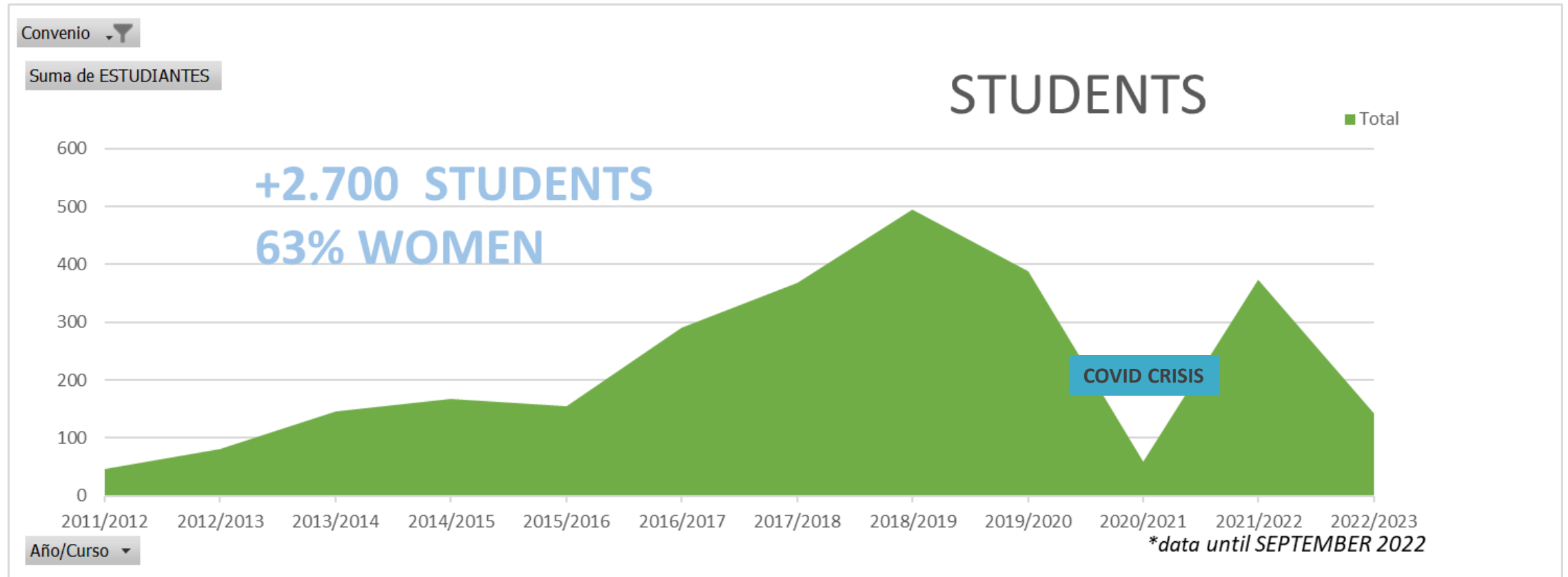

Evolution of teaching hours Graph



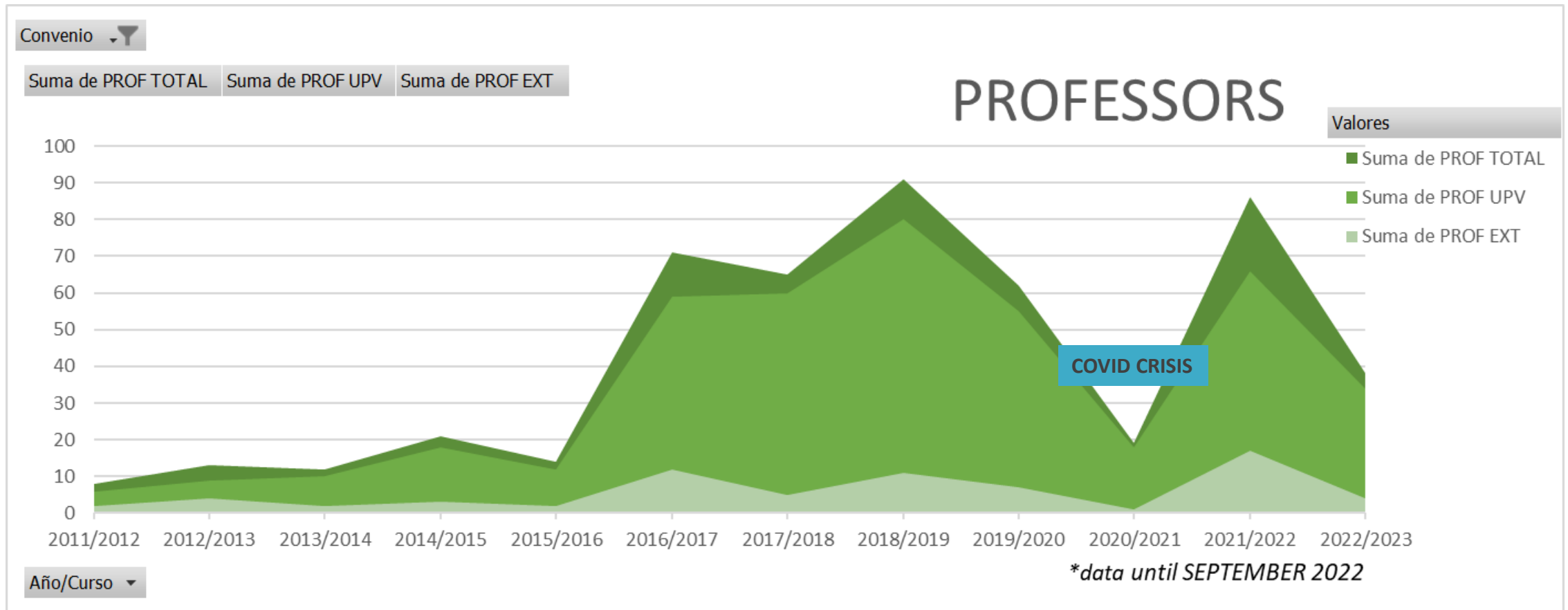
